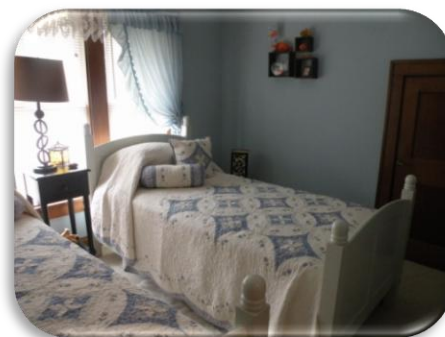
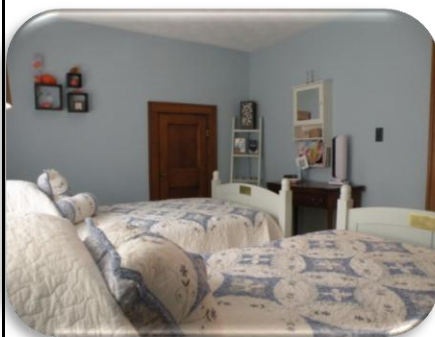
Scrapbookers' Bed and Breakfast Open!



Scrap-n-Country meets all of Ohio's Revised Code for Bed & Breakfasts and is welcoming scrapbookers who want to stay over on a Friday and/or Saturday night in order to scrap all weekend.



SNC has two rooms for our scrappers – the goldfish room and the red heart room. The fee is \$50 per room per night and includes breakfast at a time you choose. We can talk about the options for lunch and dinner (brown bag, go out, delivered, catered).
